For any withdrawn dog after close of entry you will get your fee back only if place can be given to a dog on the waiting list.

No entries possible via fax or e-mail.

We do NOT accept checks!

With your signature under the entry forms you accept the rules and regulations of ASCA and WEWASC.

Please follow all our instructions and keep your dog/s under control.

All dogs that come to this event have to be insured and vaccinated according to local rules (e.g. rabies) - this is also valid for dogs not competing at the trial.

Please take your vaccination certificate with you.

This is an event that is announced to the state vet of this district.

Should he/she come to control the vaccination certificates and find that a dog is not vaccinated sufficiently, this dog will be disqualified.
